

How to File a Complaint

Before Filing your Complaint

Is the organization you are a member of, affiliated with a Sask Sport member Provincial Sport Organization? If no, your complaint is not admissible.

Did the incident occur during a competition and was it addressed through the competition officials or rules of the sport/competition? If so, you will need to provide this info with your complaint.

Has your complaint been filed/dealt with anywhere else? Your complaint might not be admissible if it has already been handled under a different process or jurisdiction. Please provide this info if applicable.

Can the issue be resolved without a formal complaint? If appropriate, attempt to speak with coaches, staff or the other individual involved in the dispute to resolve the matter(s).
